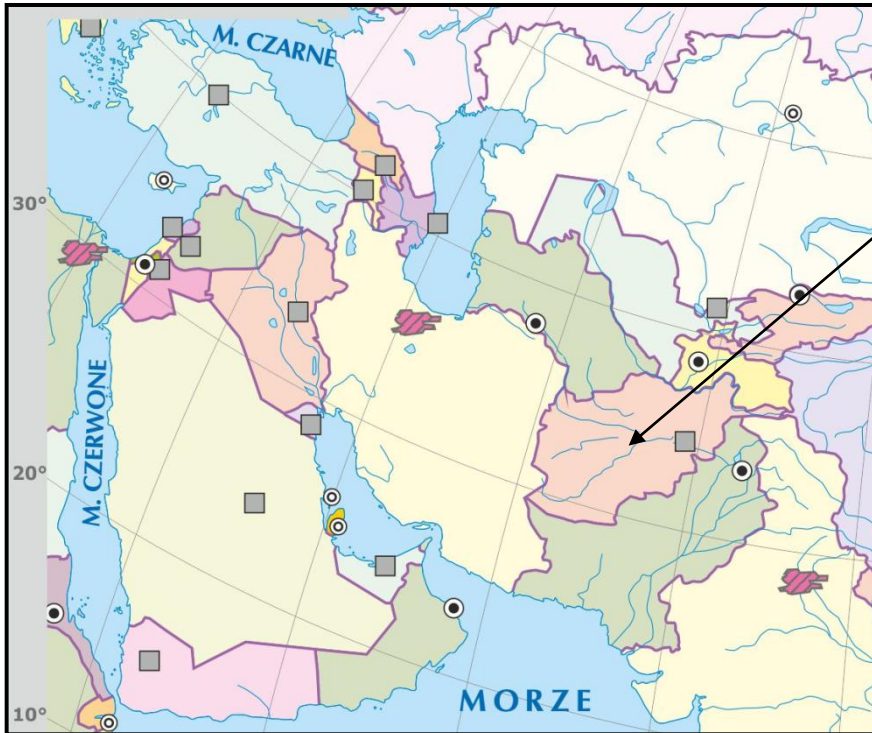


THE WAR IN AFGHANISTAN
